# **ENDOW IOWA** | TAX CREDIT PROGRAM

The Endow Iowa Tax Credit program was created in 2004 and since then has leveraged over \$311 million in endowment gifts to support lowa communities and charitable causes. This program has made nearly \$73 million in tax credits available to a wide variety of donors. For the past seven years, the annual tax credit limit has been \$6 million per year and each year every tax credit has been distributed. The program is administered by the Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA) in collaboration with the Iowa Council of Foundations (ICoF).


